

Guidelines to Submit Proposals or Manuscripts to ARP

ARP publishes books on contemporary politics, culture, and social issues. We are especially interested in works that contribute to the debates that are not often covered by mainstream publishers or media.

If you are interested in publishing with us, please send us the following:

- 1) A cover letter explaining the primary objective of your manuscript. This letter should include the work's title, its unique attributes and why you think ARP would be a suitable publisher. Please note the current state of the manuscript, when you expect it to be completed, and its approximate length. This letter should also tell us if you have any special requirements such as illustrations or photographs.
- 2) A one-page synopsis of the work and an outline of the work (or the Table of Contents).
- 3) A statement about where your work fits into its field (about one page). Please tell us who your intended audience is, what works it competes with and how it is distinct from these competitors.
- 4) A sample chapter or portion of the work.
- 5) Your curriculum vitae or resume.
